Green Standard is a non-plant derived CBD (Cannabidiol) mixed with MCT (Medium-Chain Triglycerides). In much the same way that aspirin is no longer produced from Willow Bark, non-plant derived CBD is the next evolution of high-quality CBD products. As Green Standard is not derived from cannabis, it falls outside of the Medicinal Cannabis Agency's remit (and therefore the Minimum Quality Standards) and as such is a standard Section 29 Medicine<sup>1</sup>. Green Standard CBD is bio-identical (structurally and enantiomerically) to the CBD molecule derived from the cannabis plant - but with the following features:

- **Zero Tetrahydrocannabinol (THC)**

Plant-derived CBD products can still contain minor amounts of THC and other cannabinoids. Due to the controlled manufacturing process, Green Standard CBD contains no THC.

- **Certified Facilities**

The manufacturing of Green Standard occurs in regulatory-approved facilities, much like other pharmaceutical drugs.

- **Pure CBD - Free From Pesticides, Heavy Metals and Microbes**

In plant derived CBD products there are often trace amounts of heavy metals, pesticides and microbes. As Green Standard CBD is not derived from plants and no pesticides are used in its production, there are no traces of plant or other related contaminants. This means Green Standard CBD is high quality, pure and consistent every single time.

- **A More Sustainable CBD**

Plant-derived CBD requires large volumes of water and energy to produce the cannabis crops that are then harvested and processed into CBD extracts. This process also creates a large amount of waste material that needs to be disposed of safely. Non-plant derived CBD (like Green Standard) requires a fraction of these inputs and has minimal manufacturing waste, making it a more sustainable option than plant-derived CBD.

- **Internationally Recognised and Validated**

Green Standard CBD has been validated<sup>2</sup> by the Food Standards Agency (FSA) in the UK. Please note CBD is considered a dietary supplement in the UK and therefore is regulated by the FSA.

- **Is This Like The Synthetic Cannabis We Have Heard About In The News?**

No. The CBD in Green Standard is a completely different compound, and bears no similarity to the “synthetic cannabis” you may have heard or read about in the news. Green Standard has been vigorously tested for safety, including toxicology, and is manufactured under strict laboratory conditions. The result is a synthesised CBD molecule that is structurally and enantiomerically identical to the CBD molecule found in the cannabis plant.

- **Have Cannabinoids Been Synthesised Before?**

Yes. This is not the first time that a cannabinoid has been synthesised. In 2006 the FDA approved a synthetic cannabinoid product called Nabilone that mimics the effects of THC.
